You all like chocolate. You drink chocolate milk. You eat chocolate bars and chocolate ice-cream. But do you know where chocolate comes from ? chocolate comes from beans that grow on Cacao trees. These trees grow in countries where it is warm all the time. After plucking the beans from the trees, they are roasted. Then they are removed from their shells.
