I. Helen Adams Keller (June 27, 1880 – June 1, 1968) was an American author, political activist, and lecturer. She was the first deaf and blind person to earn a Bachelor of Arts degree. The story of how Keller's teacher, Anne Sullivan, broke touched the deaf and blind girl's heart and helped her to communicate, has become widely known through the and film The Miracle Worker.

Helen Keller was not born blind and deaf; it was not until she was 19 months old that she had an illness, which might have been scarlet fever or meningitis. The illness did not last for a particularly long time, but it left her deaf and blind. At that time, she was able to communicate somewhat with Martha Washington, the six – year – old daughter of the family cook, who understood her signs; by the age of seven, she had over 60 home signs to communicate with her family.
